# THE ANSWER!

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- To better understand how the WCDSB deals with enrolment pressures we must first understand the following:
  1. Housing development
  2. Enrolment trends

Let's dive into these 2 factors!

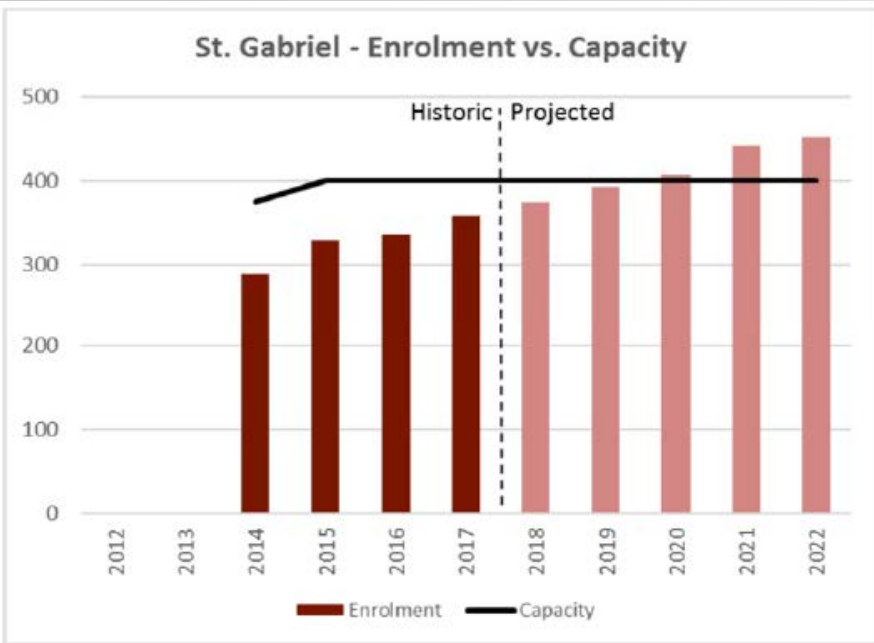
# HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

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- The Region of Waterloo provides the WCDSB with the most recent development reports every year (WCDSB is also circulated all new subdivision applications).
- WCDSB factors in all development when forecasting enrolment.
- Currently, 327 low/med density residential units are remaining to be built over the next 10 years, including the Mattamy subdivision.
- This would equate to roughly 33 students.

# ENROLMENT TRENDS



- Current capacity is 401 pupil places.
- Portables can be added to accommodate for more students, and increase the overall capacity.
- Space for 5 portables was planned when the school was built. This would bring the capacity to 516.
- More portables could be added. The maximum would depend on electrical capacity, parking spaces, and other site constraints.
